

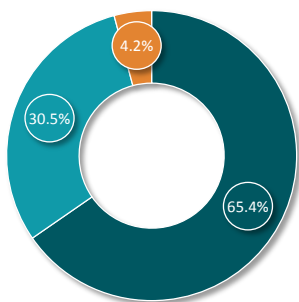

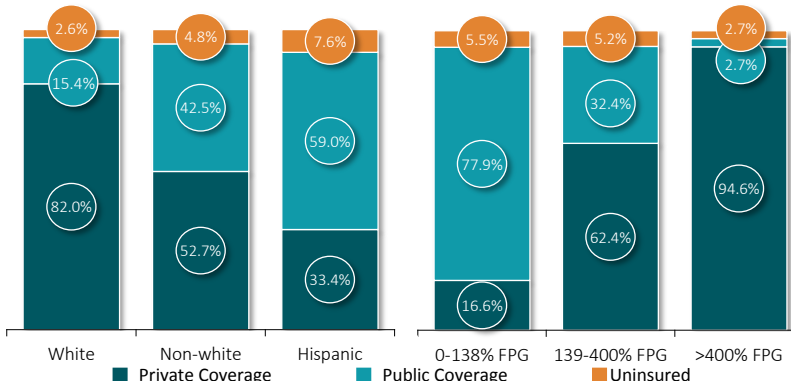

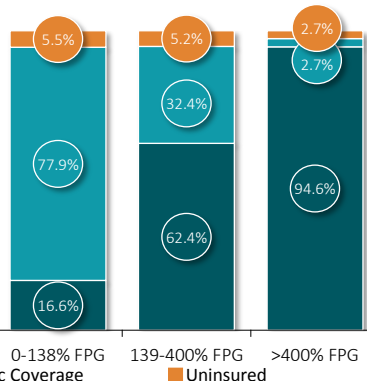

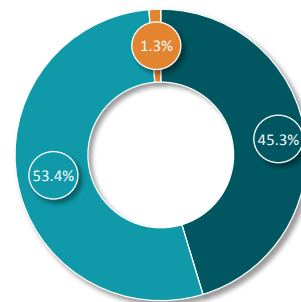
COVERAGE BY RACE/ETHNICITY



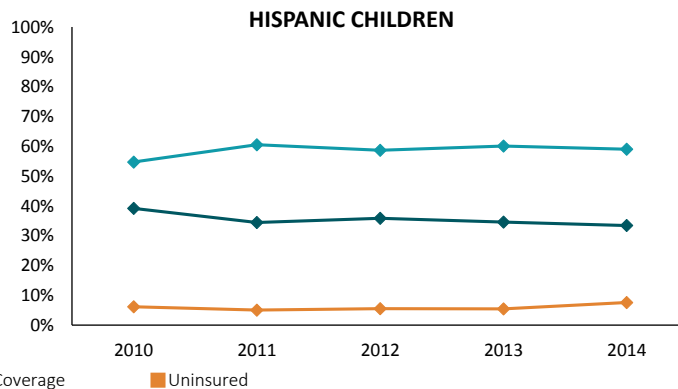
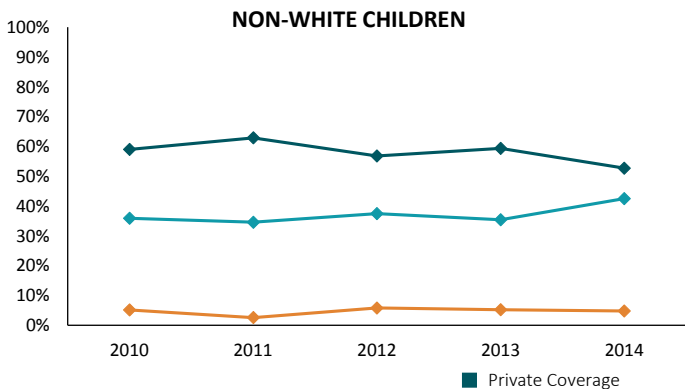
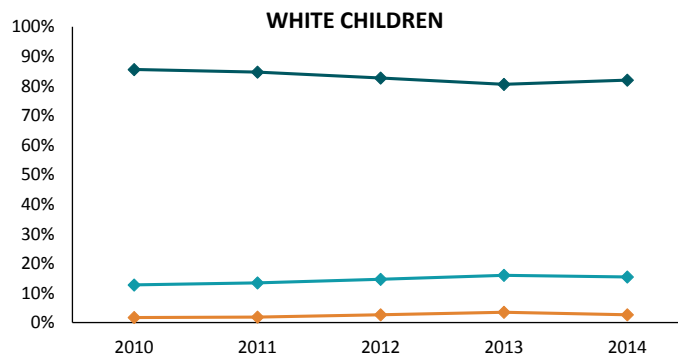
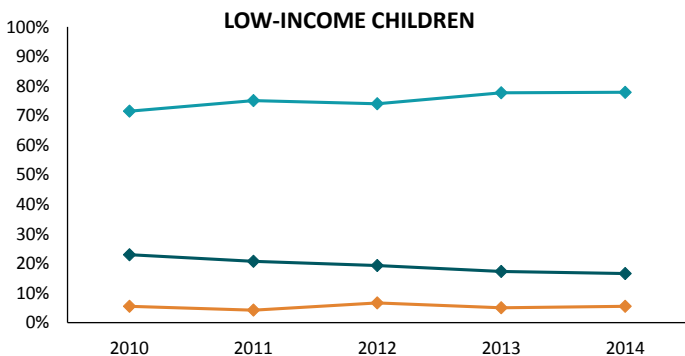
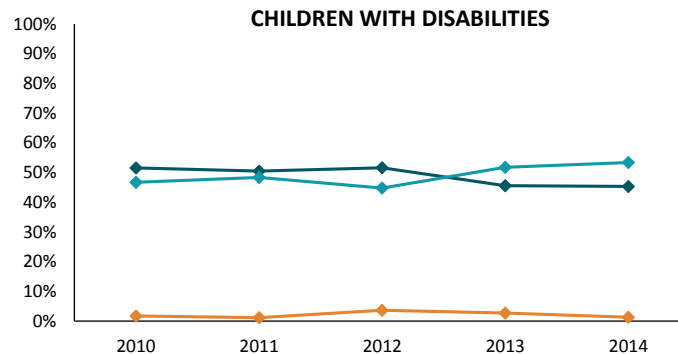
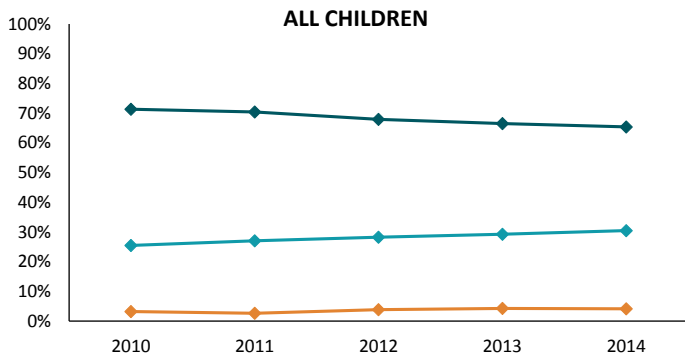
COVERAGE BY INCOME
