Figure 1. Percent change in enrollment from Feb. 2020 to Jan. 2021 in non-expansion adult eligibility group




Figure 1. Graph of enrollment percentage change from February 2020 to January 2021 in the eligibility group of non-expansion, non-aged, and non-disabled adults for states with available data. Expansion states include: Arizona, Colorado, Connecticut, Indiana, Louisiana, Minnesota, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, Ohio, and Virginia. Non-expansion states (in navy) include: Florida, Mississippi, Missouri, North Carolina, and Wisconsin.¹

Figure 2. Percent change in enrollment from Feb. 2020 to Jan. 2021 in expansion adult eligibility group




Figure 2. Graph of enrollment percentage change from February 2020 to January 2021 in the eligibility group of expansion adults for states with available data. All states are expansion states under the Medicaid expansion from the ACA.¹
